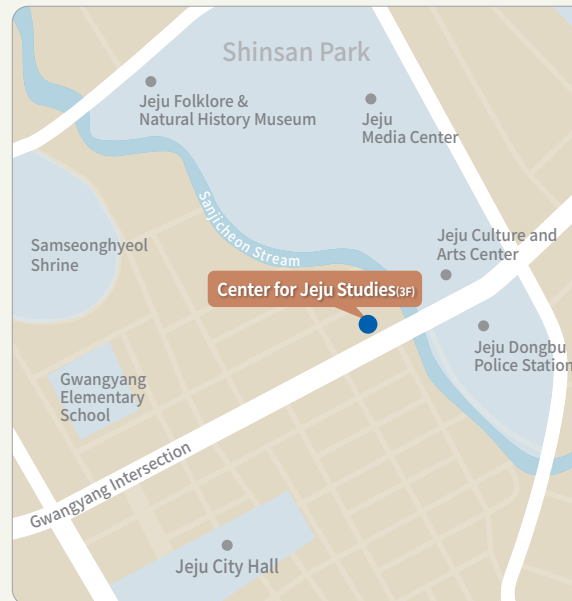

Jeju studies refers to the discipline devoted to the study of Jeju Island and its people from a systemized academic approach to the humanities, social sciences, and natural sciences that considers the island's geographical backgrounds from prehistoric times through the subsequent Tamna period. By integrating relevant disciplines, Jeju studies aims to contribute to clarifying the identity of the Jeju people and helping them embody their future.

The Center for Jeju Studies (CJS) is a public research institute established by the Jeju Special Self-Governing Province that undertakes specialized, joint, interdisciplinary research, and research support projects on the humanities, social sciences, and natural sciences of Jeju Island.
